

Rules & Regulations

How to Play: Make a selection (*use official program numbers only*) in any five (5) races Surfside offers for wagering purposes on Saturdays only. Your score will be determined by using this formula: Add the \$2 win mutual(s) and multiply by the number of winners you choose. Example: You successfully choose two (2) winners from the five (5) races. The winning mutual(s) are \$10 and \$12. The total is \$22. Multiply by two (2) winners and your score is \$44.

Your selection will be your horse for that race. In the event of a scratch, your alternate selection will become your horse for that race. If your selection and the alternate horses scratch, you will receive the betting favorite as your selection for that race. No changes will be allowed after your entry is submitted. Limit one entry per person, per contest day. Multiple entries will result in disqualification. Entries must be deposited at the Gift Shop prior to the first of the five (5) races you choose.

Eligibility: The following are ineligible to participate Surfside Race Place and 22nd DAA employees, vendors, and contractors of the 22nd DAA or Surfside, Premier employees, Local 280 mutuel employees, and SCOTWinc employees.

Prizes: No entry fee required. The 1st Place winner will receive a \$75 (seventy five dollar) betting voucher, 2nd Place winner will receive a \$50 (fifty dollar) betting voucher, and 3rd Place winner will receive a \$25 (twenty five dollar) betting voucher. In the event of a scoring tie, those contestants with the highest score will share the total prize money. The winner will be announced no later than the next day at noon and winning names will be posted at the Gift Shop. All winners must pickup their voucher awards within 14 days of the entered contest; no exceptions.

Judging and Disputes: The management at Surfside Race Place reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to this contest without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. Surfside management will make the final decisions with regards to all questions and definitions not covered explicitly in these rules.
